

Woodworkers' Checklist for Madisonville Wooden Boat Festival

All participants have their own methods, tips, and ideas, but here's a list to get you thinking as you pack for the show (in no particular order):

Note: Electricity will be available. A band saw will also be available for general use. Tables (30-32" high) and folding chairs are provided but some prefer a stool for more height. Tables are covered with plywood from our trailer.

- ⌚ Electric Drill (with spare battery if it's cordless) with 1/4" & 3/16" bits
- ⌚ Extension cord or power strip.
- ⌚ Glue gun and a shop-built protective stand to ensure that children don't touch a hot glue gun
- ⌚ The guild will supply glue sticks (7/16" x 10" all temperature)
- ⌚ Small hammer (10-12 oz.)
- ⌚ 3/4" to 1"brads 16 or 17 gauge (common wire nails) to attach rudders and movable turrets
- ⌚ Rag to clean off surface and any excess glue
- ⌚ Sandpaper or sanding block to smooth off hull edges or potential splinters
- ⌚ Regular wood glue
- ⌚ Pliers (needle nose to pull out bent nails)

Small saw (6" pull saw works great) to cut dowels, trim parts, etc.
